No Insurance expense is based on state-level figures. The cost per month includes: the cost of an existing patient doctor visit (per month), one over-the-counter headache medicine (per month), and four prescriptions (per year). The figure is the total fee for the procedure, not just the amount of the co-payment.

Dental and vision care expense is also a no insurance option, and state-level figures. The cost per month includes: two dentist cleanings of an existing patient (per year), one eye exam (per year), and one eyeglass prescription (per year). The optometrist visit estimate does not include the cost of glasses or contacts.

Additional living arrangement expenses were also not included in the total expenses. The loan taken out to cover the total expenses was based on a 10-year student loan at a 6.8% interest rate.
